



- ✓ Recycle by shape bottles, jugs, tubs, plastic cups, clamshells, food containers, trays, and plant pots



Food-Soiled Paper

✓ Un-coated (no shiny paper)



Small Items

✓ If it's not in the recycling or compostables section, put it in the trash. When in doubt, throw it out!



Scrap Metal

Must be all metal. No coatings or grease. While smaller pieces can be placed inside trash carts, larger scrap metal items will need to be called in for curbside pickup
