Holiday tree pickup is embedded in service. Curbside collection of clean, uncontaminated trees up to 6 ft. in length will occur during the first 2 scheduled pickups in January at no additional charge.

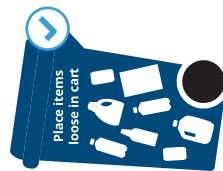

- DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES**
- NO RESIDUAL FOOD OR LIQUID**

Max. 60 lbs.

Food Scraps & Yard Waste

- ✓ Cedar Grove-approved compostable bags are OK
- ✗ **NO** plastic bags



Max. 60 lbs.

✓ Bag All Trash

- NO HAZARDOUS WASTE**
- NO LOOSE SHARPS**
- NO HOT COALS**



Max. 60 lbs.

Extra trash — fees apply

Large Appliances

Limit 3 per household



Small Appliances

2 ft. x 2 ft. x 2 ft.



Household Batteries

Place in a clear, sealed bag



Used Cooking Oil

Put in plastic jug, and label with name and address.

Limit 10 gal./year



Paper

- ✓ Keep dry



Plants & Yard Waste

- ✓ Branches 4 ft. max



Mixed Packaging

- ✓ Food-soiled
- ✓ Wrappers and bags



Fluorescent Bulbs



Wood Scraps

Place in a cardboard box next to the cart and label 'wood waste' (some metal OK)



Cardboard & Poly-Coated Cartons

- ✓ Flatten boxes
- ✓ 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 3 ft. max.
- ✓ Keep dry



Fruits & Vegetables

- ✗ No stickers



Polystyrene Foam

- ✓ Recycle for free at StyroRecycle in Kent (StyroRecycle.com)



Metal Containers

- ✓ Empty, clean and dry



Meat, Bones & Leftovers



Diapers & Pet Waste

- ✓ Please double-bag pet waste



Rigid Plastics



Glass Bottles & Jars

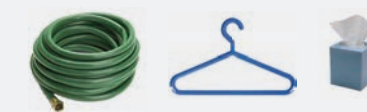
- ✓ Empty, clean and dry
- ✓ Unbroken
- ✗ No lids



Dairy, Eggs & Bread



Household Items



Plastic Bottles, Jugs & Tubs

- ✓ Empty, clean and dry
- ✓ Recycle by shape – bottles, jugs, tubs, plastic cups, clamshells, food containers, trays, and plant pots



Food-Soiled Paper

- ✓ Un-coated (no shiny paper)



Small Items

- ✓ If it's not in the recycling or compostables section, put it in the trash. When in doubt, throw it out!



Scrap Metal

Must be all metal. No coatings or grease. While smaller pieces can be placed inside trash carts, larger scrap metal items will need to be called in for curbside pickup
