

# Recycling

Empty, Clean & Dry

- ✔ **Do not bag** recyclables
- ✔ Extra recyclables may be set out in boxes, paper bags or 32-gal cans marked "Recycle" next to recycle cart.



# Organics

Food Scraps and Yard Debris

- ✔ No plastic bags
- ✔ Cedar Grove approved compostable bags are ok.
- ✔ No rocks, dirt or bark
- ✔ Extra yard waste may be collected in paper bags, 32 gal. cans or boxes 3ft. x 3ft. x 3ft max.



# Garbage

- ✔ Bag all garbage
- ✔ No hazardous waste



Paper

- ✔ clean & dry



Plants & Yard Waste

- ✔ branches 4 ft. max



Packaging

- ✔ plastic coated paper



Cardboard

- ✔ flatten boxes
- ✔ 3ft. x 3ft. x 3ft. max.



Fruits & Vegetables

- ✔ no stickers
- ✔ fees may apply

Meat, Bones & Leftovers



Diapers & Pet Waste

- ✔ Double bagged



Scrap Metal

- ✔ 2ft. x 2ft. x 2ft. max.



Dairy, Eggs Bread



Glass & Ceramics

- ✔ broken



Glass Bottles & Jars

- ✔ empty and rinse
- ✔ unbroken
- ✔ no lids



Food Soiled Paper

- ✔ uncoated (no shiny paper)



Household Items

- ✔ latex paint (dry or empty)



Plastic Bottles, Jugs and Tubs

- ✔ empty and rinse
