Plastic hangers*



Empty motor oil & antifreeze containers



Candy wrapper & chip bags



Styrofoam bakery & meat trays, take-out containers *(reuse styrofoam packing & peanuts*)*



Caps & lids *(under 3", remove from containers)*



Empty prescription vials



Plastic plate & utensils

Glass



Mirrors, window glass, ceramic dishes, incandescent & halogen bulbs *(no fluorescent tubes/bulbs*)*

Metal



Oil containers, dried-out paint containers, aerosol spray cans



Caps, rings & lids



Metal hangers* & sharp or greasy metal

**Tip: Donate hangers to a local charity or return to your dry cleaner to be used again.*

Miscellaneous



Vacuum cleaner bags



Cold cigarette butts & ashes. *Put in bag and tie shut.*



CDs & CD cases



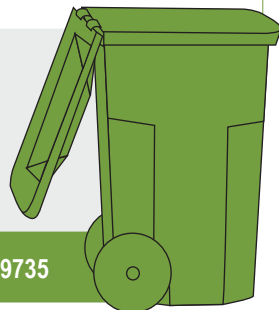
Double bagged pet waste & litter
