Important Information Regarding the New County-Wide Curbside Recycling Program

Working Towards the Greater, Greener Good.

Summit County is implementing a new and expanded recycling curbside pickup program, beginning the week of July 2, 2012. This new program will provide curbside service throughout Summit County to all households, excluding cabin and remote areas. This expanded program means that less waste will go into the County landfill and more households will benefit from convenient curbside recycling. This entire recycling program is for residential service only.

What Can I Expect With My Trash and Recycling?

All current waste carts in the County (whether brown or blue) will turn into recycling carts. All residents will receive new GREY waste carts in the next month. You can begin using the new grey carts for waste after your last service day in June; the new carts will not begin to be emptied until the 1st week of July. If you have been participating in curbside recycling, please note that all recycling will now go into your former waste cart (brown or blue) and can be co-mingled, which will eliminate sorting your recyclables. Please note that glass will NOT be accepted for curbside recycling. Glass as well as food waste will contaminate your recycling bin. Republic Services will deliver the new grey waste cart, which will have an information packet attached to help answer any questions you may still have. Homes that are currently using more than one waste cart will have the second cart removed. Going forward, additional waste carts will need to be specially ordered; a separate letter will come to residents with more detail.

NOTE: Trash service will continue on a weekly basis. See the schedule below.

Summit County 2012-2013 Recycle Service Schedule

Every other week starting in July 2012

- All containers must be placed outside by 7:00 a.m.
- Do not place trash in recycle containers; they will not be emptied.
- Place container in street with wheels against the curb within two feet of the blacktop.
- Place containers 4 feet from other containers and 8 feet from mailboxes, poles, fences, trees, or parked vehicles.
- Break down cardboard boxes.

Acceptable Curbside Recycling Items:

Please empty, clean and crush all containers and break down/flatten boxes.

- Plastics #1-#7
 - Including plastic bags (caps and lids left on the bottles are okay.)
- Aluminum beverage cans
- Tin cans
 - Labels left on the cans are okay.
- All paper including:
 - Newspapers
 - Junk mail
 - Corrugated cardboard
 - Paperboard
 - Phone books
 - Office and notebook paper

Unacceptable Curbside Recycling Items:

- Food contaminated items
 - Pizza boxes, paper towels and paper napkins.
- Styrofoam
 - Please remove these items from the cardboard boxes you may be recycling. Recycle Utah accepts solid Styrofoam and packing peanuts.
- Glass
 - Accepted at Recycle Utah.
- Green Waste
- Tree/shrub trimmings may be taken to Three Mile Landfill for chipping. Grass clippings, yard waste, and organic food waste work well in a home composting system. Learn how to compost at Recycle Utah.
- Thermometers
 - Accepted at Recycle Utah.
- Small appliances
- Wax coated cardboard
- Scrap metal



- Batteries

Many unacceptable items listed above may be dropped off at the following locations:

- **Recycle Utah:** 1951 Woodbine Way, Park City
- **Coalville Public Drop-off:** 50 West 40 South, Coalville, UT.
 - Open 24/7 and accepts mixed paper, cardboard, aluminum and mixed metal.
- **Three Mile Landfill:** accepts mixed paper, cardboard, aluminum, mixed metal and yard waste.
